Angelia's influence is not confined to her immediate roles; she has also contributed to the broader field of nursing and emergency preparedness through various publications. Her articles in paramedic textbooks, EMS magazines, and community newsletters highlight essential topics such as Community and Individual Emergency Preparedness, demonstrating her commitment to improving public health and safety.
