With her board certification from the American Board of Family Medicine and a Certificate of Added Qualification (CAQ) in Sports Medicine, Dr. Abraham is well-equipped to provide comprehensive care to her patients. Her membership extends to the American Academy of Family Physicians, the American College of Sports Medicine, and the American Medical Society for Sports Medicine.

In addition to her clinical practice, Dr. Abraham serves as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at McGovern Medical School at UTHealth Houston. Her role extends beyond academia as she is actively involved with the local community, serving as a team physician for Spring Branch Independent School District and the medical staff for the Chevron Houston Marathon.

Demonstrating her commitment to community health through various philanthropic efforts in Detroit, Dr. Abraham organized a women's health event for female athletes at Wayne State University in 2023, led an asthma workshop at Downtown Boxing Gym in 2022, supported the Renaissance High School Medical Club from 2022-2023, contributed to Detroit Street Medicine throughout her time in residency, and participated in Fit Kids on the Move, highlighting her dedication to improving healthcare access for underserved populations.
