Noise Service: New Album: FEB 27: Tractor Tavern





This DIY approach allowed time to experiment with layers of guitars, harmonies, and unconventional sounds like vibraslaps, windchimes, and <u>audio of NASA's Ganymede flyby</u>. Mixed and mastered by <u>Jack Endino</u> in 2024, the album combines raw

creativity with professional polish.
