As the only female US residency and fellowship-trained pediatric ophthalmologist in El Paso, Dr. Radenovich is board-certified in ophthalmology by the American Board of Ophthalmology, and in integrative medicine by the American Board of Physician Specialties. Furthermore, she is an active member of several esteemed medical organizations, including the American Academy of Ophthalmology, the American Association for Pediatric Ophthalmology & Strabismus, the Texas Medical Association, the Texas Pediatric Ophthalmology Association, and the El Paso County Medical Society.

In addition to her commitment to her practice, Dr. Radenovich serves as a Clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of Pediatrics at the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of Medicine. Her contributions to the field extend beyond the clinic, having authored numerous lectures and publications.
