
New Theatrical Production Where I Belong Begins Development

The production will feature interactive moments where performers connect directly with audience members—fostering a sense of emotional presence and communal connection.

"We want audiences to feel immersed in Sage's journey, not just as spectators but as witnesses," Porter explains. "By breaking staging conventions and introducing interactive elements, we hope to blur the lines between performance and lived experience."

"For a long time, I didn't see stories like mine being told," says Porter. "Where I Belong is the story I needed growing up—one that embraces the complicated, beautiful process of self-discovery. It's a message to anyone who has ever felt unseen: You belong."

Porter's personal experiences with identity, grief, and healing form the backbone of the production, which aims to foster empathy, representation, and accessibility for audiences of all backgrounds.
