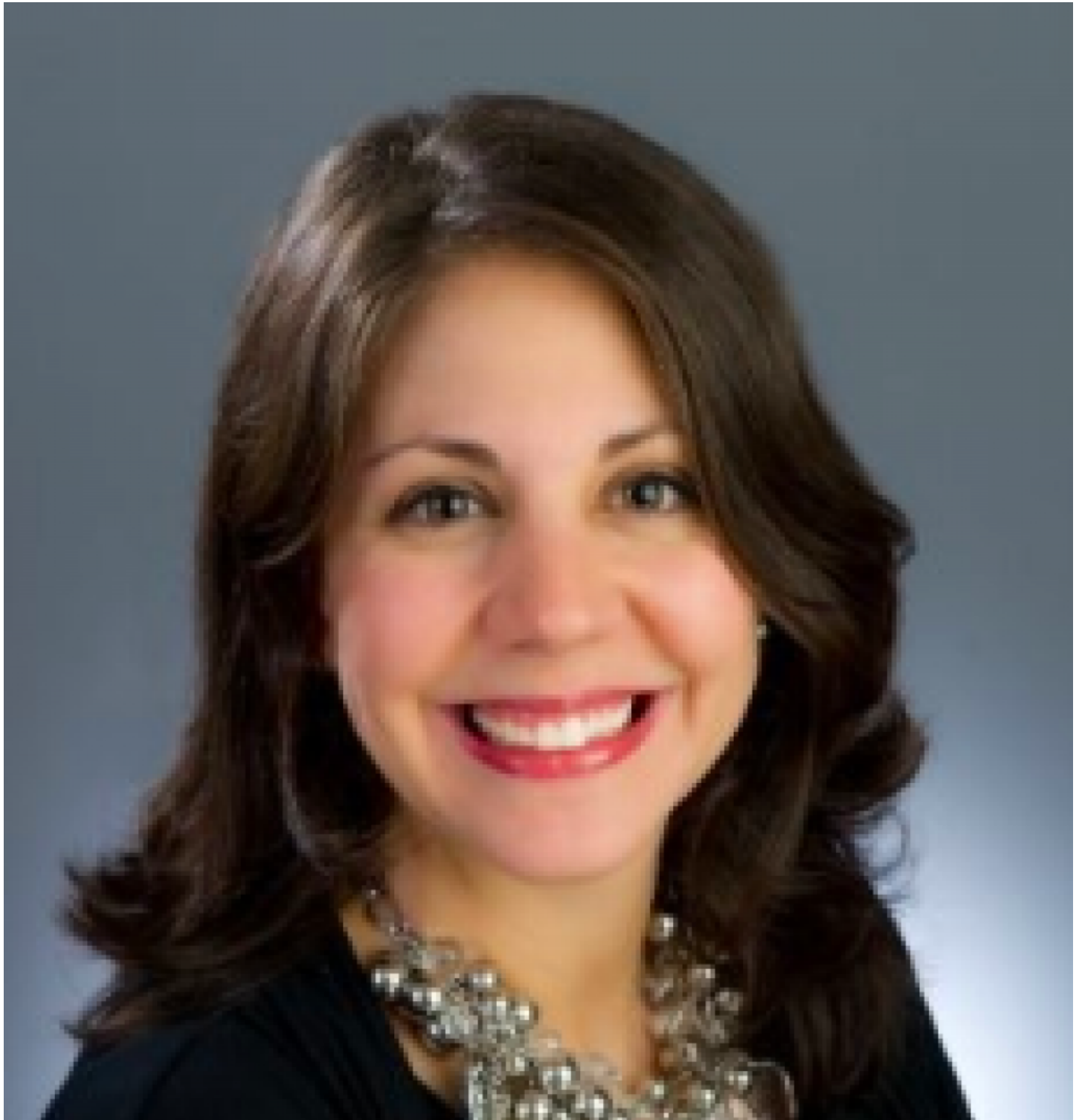


Teresa Segrest, RN, CPAN: A Beacon of Dedication and Excellence in Nursing at DCH Health System
