Academically, the doctor completed his medical education at Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1994 before pursuing further training in general surgery at Vanderbilt University Medical Center and Ohio State University Medical Center, affiliated with Doctors Hospital in Columbus, Ohio. His passion for vascular surgery led him to a fellowship at the prestigious Walter Reed National Military Medical Center in 2010.

With more than 24 years of service in the U.S. Armed Forces. Dr. Martin was trained and selected for the US Army Special Forces and served in the 10th SFG (A) at Fort Carson, Colorado, in the late 90s into the early part of the millennium. He also served with distinction and honor with Joint Special Operations Command (JSOC), working as part of an elite four-man surgical resuscitation team at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. He completed a three-year tour deploying down range to hostile combat zones in a wartime environment. Dr. Martin brings a unique perspective to his practice, having dedicated his career to the health and well-being of others, taking care of those who cannot take care of themselves – "De Oppresso Liber".
