

## From Battlefield to Breakthrough: The Military History of Shockwave Therapy

The military history of shockwave discovery and research dates back to World War I (1914-1918) when high-energy shockwaves from explosive blasts were first observed to cause internal injuries without visible external trauma. Soldiers exposed to bomb explosions often suffered from internal organ damage, brain trauma, and lung injuries — a phenomenon that puzzled medical professionals. This effect was later termed "blast injury", marking the earliest documentation of shockwaves impacting human tissue.

In World War II (1939-1945), military scientists intensified their study of shockwaves as they were linked to air blast injuries from bombs, torpedoes, and heavy artillery. The German military and Luftwaffe physicians observed that shockwaves from explosions could cause concussive trauma, lung hemorrhages, and bone fractures without penetrating wounds. This discovery led to extensive military medical research to understand the biological impact of shockwaves on human tissue.

By the 1950s, military research pivoted toward harnessing shockwaves for medical purposes. German and Swiss military scientists explored how focused shockwaves could be used therapeutically, inspired by their ability to fragment solid objects. Early military-funded experiments focused on destroying kidney stones (lithotripsy) without surgery — a breakthrough that eventually led to the development of the first shockwave lithotripsy device in 1980. This device, developed by Dornier MedTech in collaboration with the German military, used focused shockwaves to disintegrate kidney stones non-invasively, revolutionizing urology.

In the 1990s, military-funded research extended to orthopedic and musculoskeletal medicine. Scientists discovered that low-intensity shock waves could stimulate bone regeneration, accelerate wound healing, and reduce chronic pain by increasing blood circulation and collagen production. Shockwave therapy was particularly effective for treating non-healing fractures, tendon injuries, and chronic musculoskeletal pain — making it a valuable treatment for combat-injured soldiers.


