The organization has also launched the "Got Trump Challenge," a social media campaign encouraging creative storytelling through photography and video content, with monthly prizes awarded across multiple categories.

Planned Acts of Kindness emphasizes that all proceeds support their public education initiatives, focusing on socialization skills, mental health resources, and career development programs for communities in need.
