Shane Alexander Harvey, AKA Creepzz, a UK-based rapper, is set to release a heartfelt tribute song in honor of *Lee Rigby*, the British soldier tragically killed in 2013. Written in 2014, the song reflects on the horror of Rigby's murder, the justice served, and the lasting impact on his family. After holding onto the track for years, Creepzz has finally found the courage to release it, hoping to reignite awareness and keep Lee Rigby's memory alive.

"This song sat with me for so long," Creepzz explains. "I wrote it while going through my own mental health struggles, and seeing what happened to Lee just hit me hard. I felt compelled to put it into words. Now, I feel it's the right time to share it because you don't hear much about Lee anymore, and he shouldn't be forgotten."

Set for release on **March 31st**, the song and accompanying lyric video—dropping on Creepzz's [YouTube channel](#) in the next two days—serve as a powerful reminder of the tragedy and the importance of remembering those we've lost. Creepzz [Creepzz](#) has pledged that **all revenue from the song will**

go towards the Lee Rigby Foundation, supporting the family and continuing Lee's legacy.

"I just want people to hear this song and reflect," says Creepzz. "It's not just about honoring Lee, but also showing young people that life offers better paths than violence. If this song can make someone think twice or inspire change, that's what matters."

With other media outlets eager to cover the story, Creepzz chose to speak directly, sharing his personal connection to the project and his desire for the song to resonate with listeners. His raw, emotional tribute is set to strike a chord with audiences, ensuring that Lee Rigby's name and story continue to be remembered.
