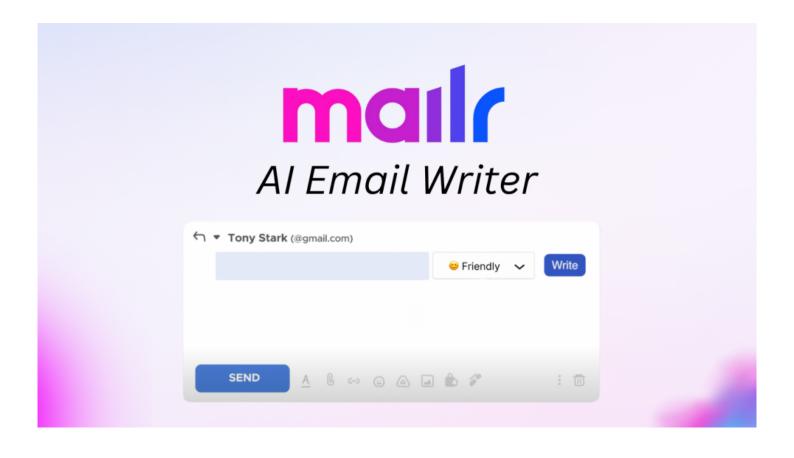
16-Year-Old Sells Al Startup to Y Combinator Founder
