Key features include a spacious multipurpose area for large member meetings, a dedicated boardroom, and thoughtfully designed spaces that reflect the League's professionalism and community impact since its establishment in 1957.

The ribbon-cutting event included remarks by JLS President Laura Conaboy and Craig McGonigal, Director of Membership Engagement from the Sarasota Chamber of Commerce, highlighting the collaborative effort behind this significant achievement. In addition, community leaders, project partners, donors, JLS leadership, and Chamber of Commerce representatives were in attendance.
