pre'cious, presh'us, *a.* 1. Highly priced or prized, as for rarity, or for intrinsic, exchangeable, or other value; said of material things when also portable and hence not large. Specifically said (1) of gems and the non-oxidizable metals, having ornamental or market value; (2) of things rare and specially interesting irrespective of beauty or market value, as relics, mementos, or valuable manuscripts; (3) of persons having peculiar excellences, as things intellectual, esthetic, or moral possessions, or a supposed superiority. Often used as a capital, as in *precious* and dilettant.

2. Of a kind to excite peculiar interest or affection; beloved and not replaceable; used substantively; as, my precious; a precious joy; as, a precious deal of trouble; or manner; a Gallicism; *OF. precios, < L. pretiosus*.

Synonyms: beloved, inestimable, valuable, rare.

Antonyms: second-hand, common, ordinary.

pre'cious-ly, presh'us-ly, *adv.* In a valuable manner; so as to be of or produce great worth; as, time preciously spent. 2. With elegance and industry; discreetly; as, to garner *preciously* the spare moments. [*Colloq.*] Exceedingly; as, my fellow was *preciously* frightened. 4. With extreme precision, fastidiously.

pre'cious-ness, presh'us-ness, *n.* The quality of being rare, valuable, costly, or highly prized; costliness; worth.

pre'cious-ly, presh'us-ly, *adv.* In a precious manner. 1. A paper containing the particulars of a writ, lodged in the office out of which the writ is to be issued, for the return of the officer who is to execute it; a written order directing the issuance of a writ.

Metaphorically, a precipitous cliff; as, a precipitous career.

pre'cip'i-ta'tion, pre-sip'i-té'shun, *n.* 1. The act of casting down; the state of being thrown downward. 2. Headlong or rash haste or hurry; precipitancy.

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Synonyms: obviate, prevent. To obviate, strictly to stop the way of or remove from the way, is to prevent by interception, so that something that would naturally withstand or disturb may be kept from doing so; to *preclude*, to close or shut in advance, is to prevent by anticipation or by logical necessity; walls and bars *precluded* the possibility of escape; a supposition is *precluded*; a necessity or a civil law is *obviated*. *Prevent*, which at first had only the anticipatory meaning, has come to apply to the stopping of an action at any stage, the completion or conclusion only being thought of as negated by anticipation; the enemy passed the out-works and were barely *prevented* from capturing the fortress. Compare HINDER; PROHIBIT.—*Preposition*: a person or thing is *precluded* from an act.

—**pre-clu'sion**, *n.* The act of precluding, or the state of being precluded; a shutting out.—**pre-clu'sive**, *a.* Tending or operating to preclude; often with *of*; as, sin is *preclusive* of happiness; adultery is *preclusive* of dowry.—**pre-clu'sive-ly**, *adv.*
