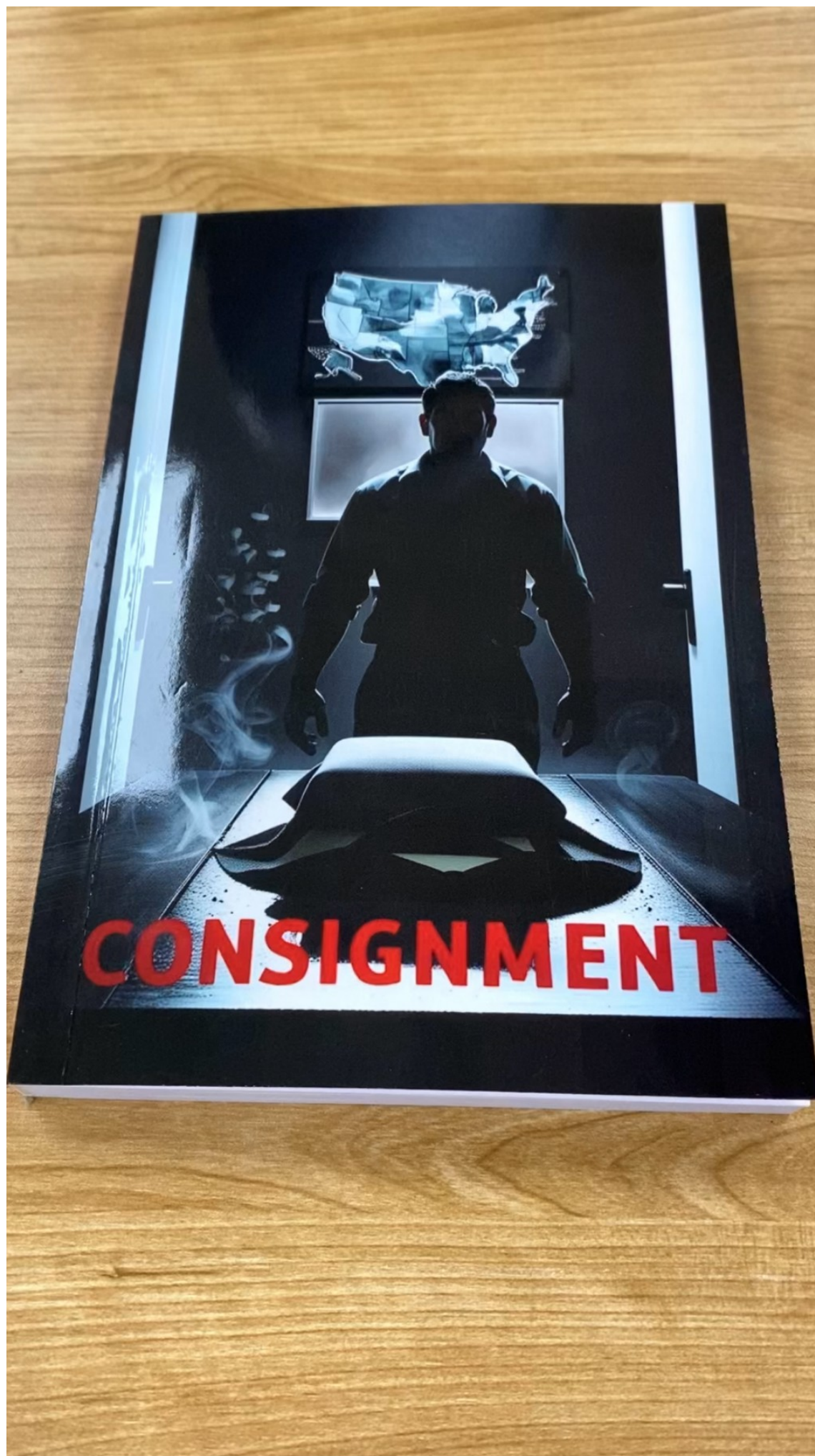


‘Consignment’ by Lenor Mansa Musa Penferd Exposes the Cost of Survival
