

Culture Commission Coalition to Hold Urgent Press Conference

Demanding Justice for Civil Rights Violation at Dallas Airport



Dallas, Texas Apr 27, 2025 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - The Culture Commission Coalition is calling on the community and the media to attend an urgent press conference & support rally addressing a grave civil rights violation. **On Monday, April 28, 2025, at 11:00 AM CT, the Coalition will spotlight the unjust treatment of Mr. Michael Singleton, an innocent man whom members of the Dallas Police Department exercised an excessive use of force.** The incident, captured on video by

concerned citizens, has since circulated globally, igniting widespread outrage and calls for justice.

The press conference will be held at George L. Allen, Sr. Courthouse, 600 Commerce St., Dallas, TX 75202, and will feature remarks from Robert Slater, Community Advocate and Founder of The Culture Commission, alongside legal experts, civil rights leaders, and directly affected individuals.

"The future belongs to those who build it — and we're here to build a community rooted in justice, accountability, and human dignity," said Robert Slater.

Mr. Singleton will personally address the media, stating:

"This incident has not only caused me physical pain but has also severely damaged my reputation. I was wrongfully branded as a drug dealer, despite no drugs being found. The stigma attached to that accusation has affected my personal and professional life in profound ways. I am calling for accountability and justice. No one should endure what I have experienced, and no one should be subjected to excessive force when they pose no threat."
