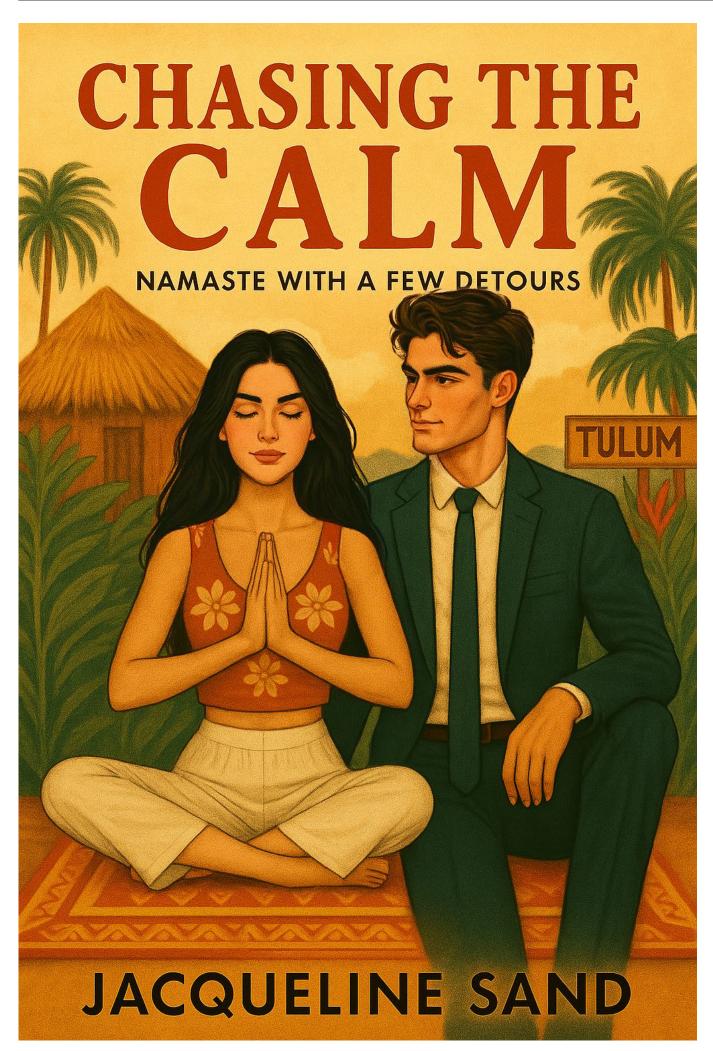
Debut Author Jacqueline Sand's Chasing the Calm Redefines & Tranforms Romance Books Genre
