Joey Dylan Broom, on behalf of the family, gave the following statement:

"My father was the greatest man that I have ever known. He taught me everything that I know and most importantly he taught me the importance of knowing Christ. Although losing him early has hurt our family badly, I know that the angels in heaven are rejoicing as we mourn we rejoice that our father will spend eternity with Christ because he accepted Jesus as his savior and lord. We hope that God uses this tragedy to grow the Kingdom of Heaven and also to make our community a safer place".
