
Has the Real Illuminati been Located? A Phoenix Christian Author Hits a Nerve with Globalists.

R.C.'s The Great Arrogation: Why America is Not a Party to the Battle of Armageddon currently remains available at Amazon.com and other international bookstores, but fears the work may not remain available at any major bookstore for much longer, due to recent events.

R.C. puts forward that he has only exercised his First Amendment rights (freedom of religion) in authoring the book, but did not wish to stir up the famous shadowy group, which has been at the center of controversy and in the social media spotlight in recent years.
