Since joining Henry Ford Hospital's Radiation Oncology Department in 1985, Dr. Dragovic has dedicated her career to providing exceptional care. Her leadership roles include serving as Medical Director of the Cancer Care Center at Macomb from 1996 to 2000 and leading the Edith McNaughton Ford Cancer Center at Cottage since 2000.
