

Jay Q Releases Emotionally Charged Single “If You” — A Soulful Look at Love, Loss, and Loyalty

A former college football player turned full-time artist, Jay Q's story is a testament to resilience. After a sports injury forced him off the field, he channeled his energy into music starting with BandLab recordings on his phone and eventually building his own home studio. His debut album *Pati3nce* introduced the world to his reflective lyricism, and *If You* pushes that emotional boundary even further.
