This act was emblematic of her approach to politics: personal, persistent, and people-first.

Cohen also made recent appearances at rallies and events supporting transgender rights and received recognition from several organizations for her advocacy efforts, with more details to be highlighted in future announcements.

Cohen's history of advocacy dates back well before her current leadership positions. In 2018, she ran for Austin City Council (District 3), with a campaign focused on affordability, land use, and opposing discriminatory policies such as the then-proposed anti-transgender bathroom bill.
