## Lin Honeycutt Featured in Exclusive Interview on Faith, Farming, and a Life of Purpose

Raleigh Entrepreneur Reflects on Legacy, Leadership, and 2 Million Christmas Lights

"My days are still full—just different," Honeycutt says in the interview. "I may not be coordinating disaster relief or running an auto shop anymore, but I'm still busy."

The feature dives into Lin's time as a Regional Coordinator with the North Carolina Baptist Men for 19 years and Brotherhood Director for the Raleigh Baptist Association for 17 years. Though retired from official roles since 2021, he remains a faithful servant within his church, known today as the head cook and committee leader.

The interview also highlights the evolution of Fieldstream Farm. The farm is more than a venue—it's also a working farm producing hay, tobacco, and eggs from over 50 chickens. The property hosts more than 50 events annually and draws crowds during the holiday season with a mile-long, drive-through

light display featuring over two million lights.

"People don't just come for the lights," Lin says. "They come to make memories."

In the Q&A, Lin shares advice, life lessons, and personal habits that have helped him grow businesses and remain grounded through life's challenges. From daily list-making to stepping away from distractions by walking his farm, he offers insights that are practical and deeply rooted in his values.

"Generosity changes the giver more than the receiver," he notes. "That's something I've experienced over and over."

Lin also discusses faith outside of formal ministry, emphasizing that impactful work often happens in everyday settings—garages, kitchens, and cornfields. He encourages others to give without expecting anything in return, something he continues to model through his church work and support for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.
