

High-level Forum on China–Thailand Intelligent Manufacturing and Industrial Cooperation Held



Quezon City, Metropolitan Manila Area Jun 18, 2025 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - On May 14, 2025, the highly anticipated China–Thailand Intelligent Manufacturing and Industrial Cooperation High-Level Forum was successfully held in Bangkok. Key stakeholders from both countries gathered under the framework of Thailand's "Industry 4.0" roadmap to explore industrial synergies. This forum marked a significant milestone in deepening bilateral industrial ties and promoting sustainable cooperation in intelligent manufacturing and automation.

The event was organized by the China Chamber of Commerce for Import and Export of Machinery and Electronic Products (CCCME), co-organized by Hangzhou Tanda Machinery Import and Export Co., Ltd., and undertaken by Ringier Trade Media Ltd.
