

QREDIV® Foundation Denounces Scam Misuse of Its Name in Fake UN Job Offer Targeting Job Seekers

The QREDIV® Certificate is a legitimate diversity and inclusion training program, unaffiliated with any job scams or crypto solicitations.

London, United Kingdom Jun 17, 2025 ([IssueWire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - Alpha Learning Solutions Ltd., the official provider of the QREDIV® Certificate, today issued a public statement condemning the unauthorized and fraudulent use of its brand in a scam involving fake United Nations job offers. The organization has no connection to the scam and is actively working to correct the misinformation being circulated online.

The case involves a victim who reported being misled into purchasing a QREDIV® Certificate as part of a bogus recruitment process. The scammers impersonated the FAO (Food and Agriculture Organization of the UN), falsely claimed to require QREDIV® certification, and directed payment through untraceable cryptocurrency wallets. The QREDIV® Team was not involved in any way and does not solicit crypto payments outside of its official checkout page at <https://getqrediv.com> or <https://bettertolerance.com>.

"We are deeply concerned that our legitimate educational program was misrepresented as part of a fraudulent scheme," said a spokesperson for Alpha Learning Solutions Ltd. "We are taking legal and technical steps to request clarification from media outlets and remind the public to verify all official certifications and job-related documents directly with the organizations involved."

The QREDIV® Certificate is an independent, self-paced training program that offers education on emotional intelligence, multicultural workplace dynamics, and inclusion best practices. It is not affiliated with the United Nations, FAO, or any government agency, and no part of the course is required for employment by those entities.

To help the public, Alpha Learning Solutions Ltd. has published public alerts on its websites <https://getqrediv.com> and <https://bettertolerance.com> clearly alerting that "We are **not affiliated with the United Nations**, the FAO, or any similar entity. We do **not offer jobs or employment opportunities** as a result of completing any of our courses. Never send money to unknown third parties claiming such connections."
