Dr. Takahiro Yonemura holds a Doctorate in Engineering from Kindai University and has published over 68 books in Japanese and English.


He is active as an AI researcher, educator (currently teaching at university and technical colleges), and composer (including the "Recycled Brain" soundtrack on major platforms).
