The moment these steps are disrupted—especially the leveling—the labor required to undo the damage multiplies, often requiring a full day's work from technicians.

"People don't realise how finely tuned these tables are," explained a veteran installer. "One uneven leg can alter the entire table dynamics. The slate alone weighs over 200kg and must be balanced perfectly across the frame."

- Stripped bolts
- Warped leg brackets
- Damaged frame joints
- Irreversible felt tears

"It's not just a heavy table. It's a calibrated system. Treating it like a couch or cabinet is a very costly mistake," said a technical field supervisor from a Queensland-based moving firm.
