“These families didn’t choose this war. Their silence is a cry for help,” says Sara Mirzaee, Marketing & Outreach Director of Child Foundation. “When bombs fall, hope must rise. We are committed to bringing dignity, nutrition, and basic support to those who need it most—mothers, children, and the elderly.”
