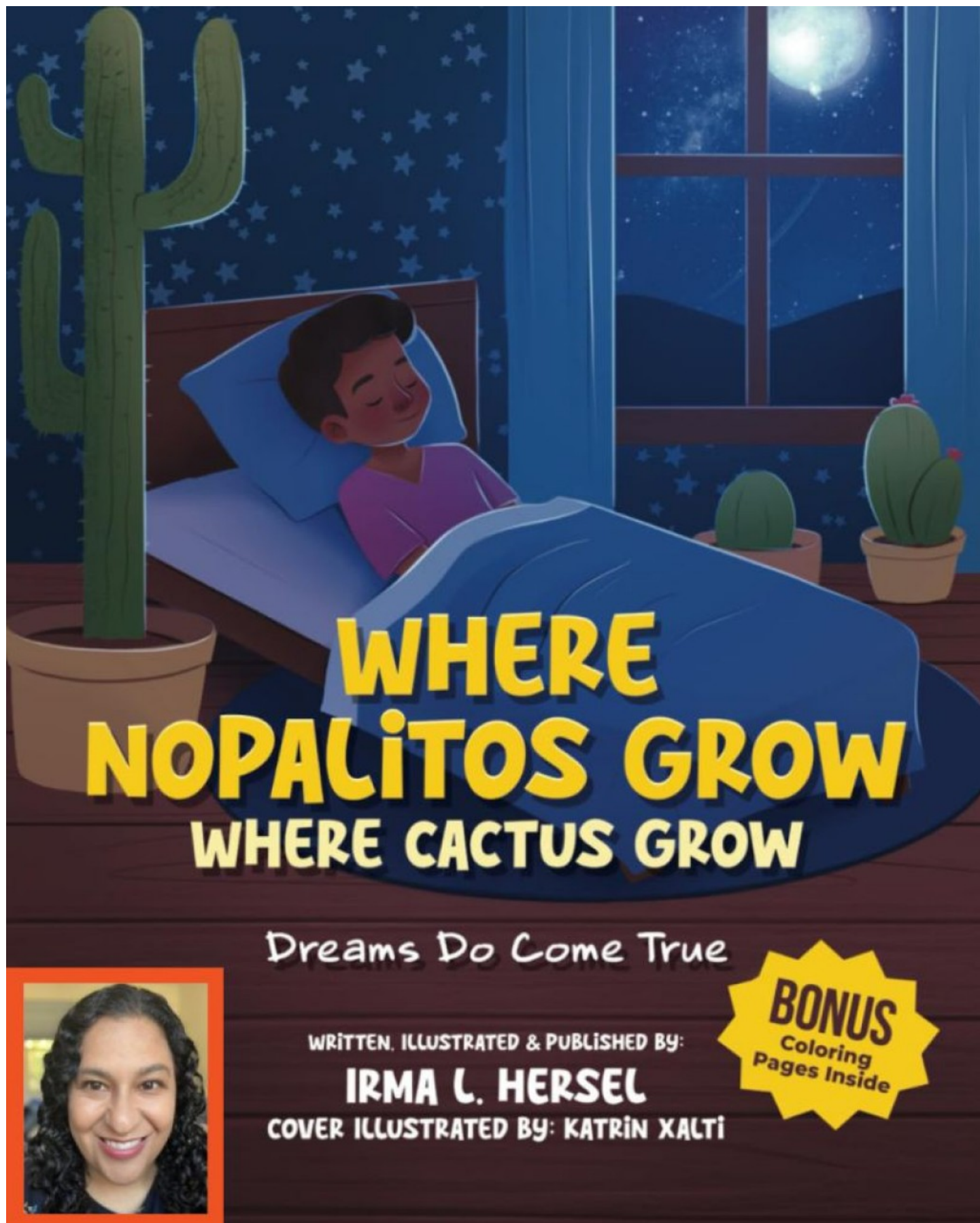


Family, Flavor & Tradition Shine in “Where Nopalitos Grow” — Bilingual Kids’ Book with Bonus Recipe & Downloads
