
Lauralee Yalden, MD, FAAFP: A Trailblazer in Telemedicine and Family Care

Dr. Yalden holds several professional affiliations, including being a Diplomate of the American Board of Family Medicine and a Fellow of the American Academy of Family Physicians (FAAFP). She is also the Founder and past Chair of the AAFP Telehealth Member Interest Group (MIG), reflecting her commitment to advancing telehealth in family medicine.

Over the years, telehealth has undergone significant transformations, especially accelerated by the COVID-19 pandemic, which showcased its versatility as a healthcare delivery method.
