"These changes in streaming economics disproportionately benefit major labels while punishing new voices. If we don't act now, we risk closing the door on tomorrow's music creators," says Johnny Holmgren, founder of MusicianAid.

MusicianAid aims to build visibility, spark global listening, and create an active community that helps artists gain traction—without needing industry gatekeepers.
