Reprint Media, a Black woman-owned creative studio, introduces *Plot Girls*—a faceless scripted podcast blurring the line between audio and cinema. Layered with suspense, visual storytelling, and coded clues, this series redefines urban noir in the podcast space.

Only 2–5% of all podcasts are scripted. Even fewer are created by Black women. *Plot Girls* fills the gap with a franchise-worthy mystery world already gaining attention across both the audio and film industries.

“This isn't just a show. It's an episodic world with licensing potential,” says S. Horne, founder and Chief Visionary Officer of Reprint Media.

With each episode crafted for cinematic sound design and future screen adaptation, *Plot Girls* blends pitch-ready scenes, immersive ambiance, and character-driven suspense. Think: high-stakes storytelling with visuals you hear.

Reprint Media is also the studio behind *Color Outside the Pain* (an adult healing-focused coloring book series) and *No Witnesses at 162* (a novel drenched in betrayal, glamor, and mystery). The studio continues to scale across books, audio, merchandise, and film-ready IP.

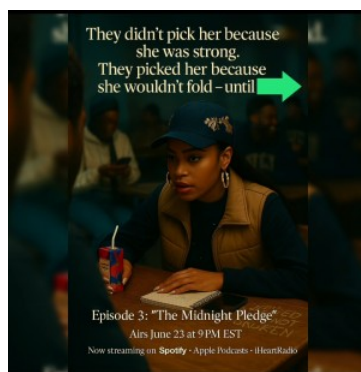
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
