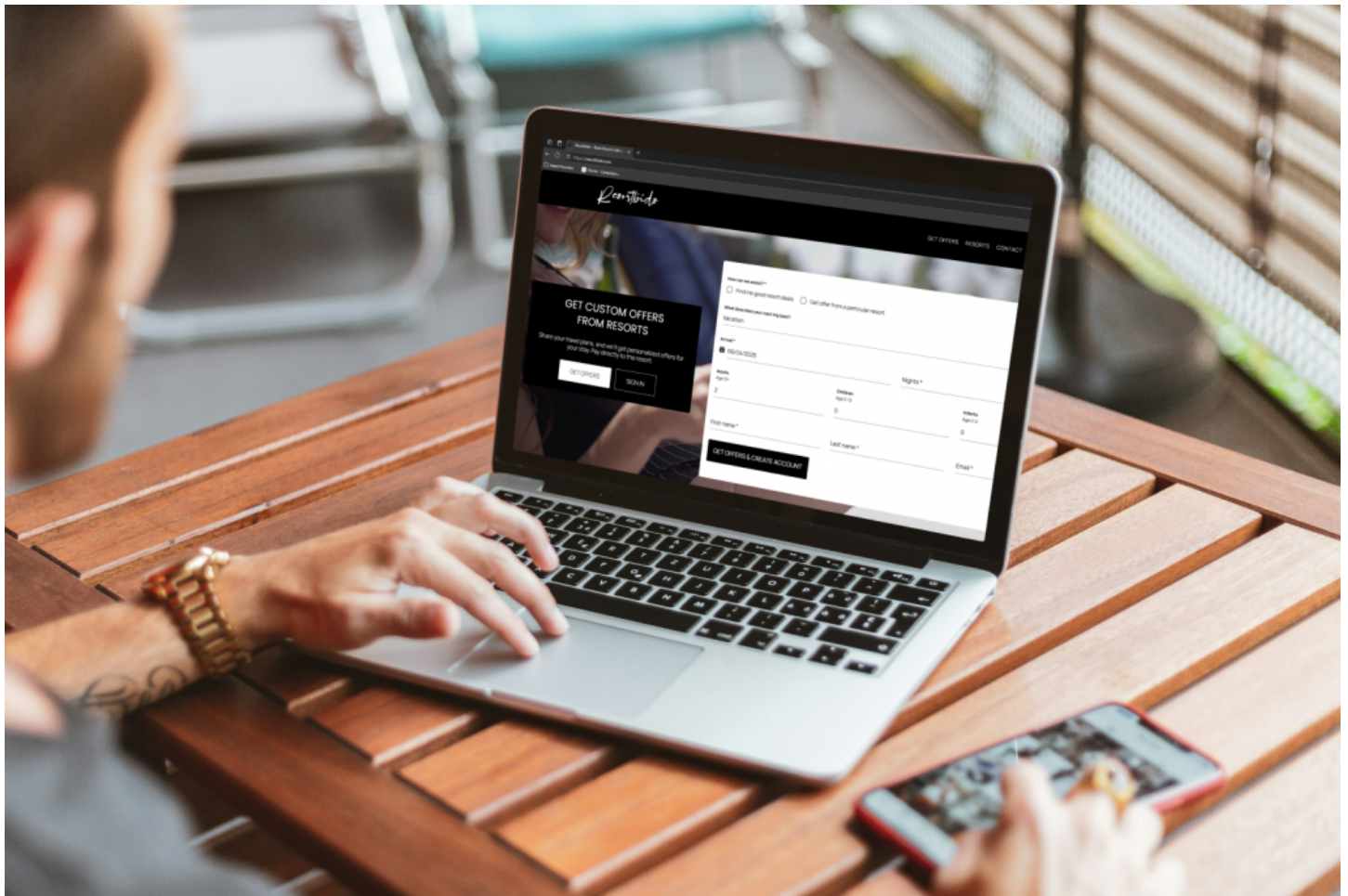


Resorts Compete for Your Trip on New Travel Platform

“Travellers need to be in control. It’s a tool designed to benefit both travellers and resorts,” says Diosi. “Users receive tailored proposals, and resorts gain access to genuine leads paying a 10% commission fee.”

The platform is free to use. Early users have reported multiple resort responses within 24–48 hours of submitting their requests, often including value-added perks like free upgrades, private transfers, or extended stay bonuses.

Resortbids is geared toward both independent travellers and those planning special occasions like honeymoons, anniversaries, or group getaways. Resorts, in turn, get a chance to fill available inventory through direct engagement.

The company plans to expand its outreach to resort operators globally while continuing to test new features that improve matchmaking quality and user experience.
