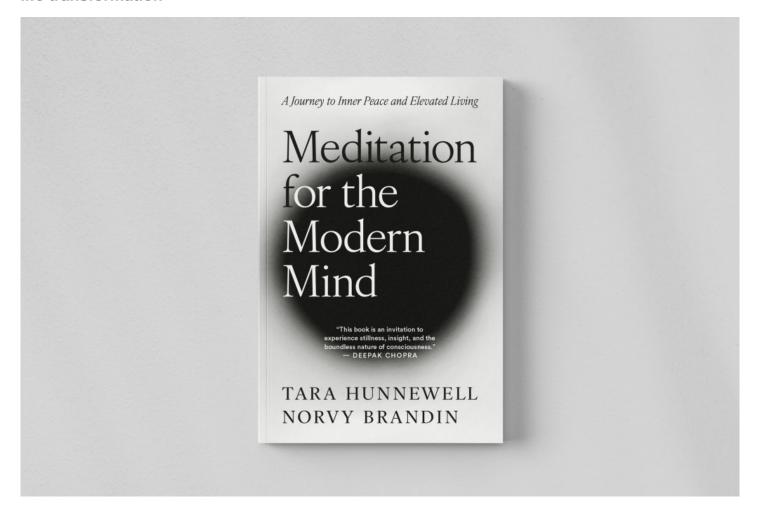
The NOW Releases "Meditation for the Modern Mind," Offering a Grounded Path to Inner Peace in a Distracted World
