"Jacobo brings the perfect blend of technical know-how and genuine care for young athletes," said **Freddy Lindo**, President of the organization. "But what truly sets him apart is his community spirit. His influence will reach far beyond race results—he'll help young people build discipline, confidence, and a lifelong connection to health and teamwork."

Melcer's community impact extends far beyond cycling. For years, he has worked to improve digital access across the South Bay, drawing on more than two decades of leadership in internet and technology companies. He has advised nonprofits, schools, and civic leaders on closing the connectivity gap—something he sees as essential for educational equity and long-term mobility.

In his corporate career, Melcer has led ventures such as **iTrackr Systems** and **Superclick, Inc.**, specializing in digital communication for healthcare and hospitality. Since 1998, he has served as President of **FrontCom.com**, a company that reflects his steady, service-driven approach to business leadership.

"Jacobo blends business sense with heart," said a colleague of 15 years. "He's never in it for the spotlight. He's in it to help, to mentor, and to make his community stronger."

In 2024, Melcer was honored with the **Community Anchor Award** by **VeloYouth**, a recognition of his long-standing commitment to youth empowerment.
