

CST Unveils Side Event at Global Symposium for Regulators

TEDxRiyadh sessions will begin on September 2, forming part of the side event’s program. The global platform presents inspiring visions and exceptional experiences in fields such as technology and AI. The sessions will highlight the human being’s central role through powerful personal stories that explore the human impact of technological advancement.

The event will also present a series of expert-led panel discussions and interactive presentations exploring key regulatory themes. These include the future of AI in the 6G (sixth-generation) era, the governance of quantum technologies, and the integration of terrestrial and non-terrestrial networks to support global connectivity. It will further highlight outcomes from SpaceUp, a CST initiative that seeks to develop space-based solutions to address pressing challenges across vital sectors.

As a whole, the event extends CST’s efforts to position the Kingdom as a global hub for innovation and digital regulation. It contributes to the goals of the digital economy, promotes long-term digital sustainability, strengthens next-generation infrastructure, and empowers technologies that connect humanity.
