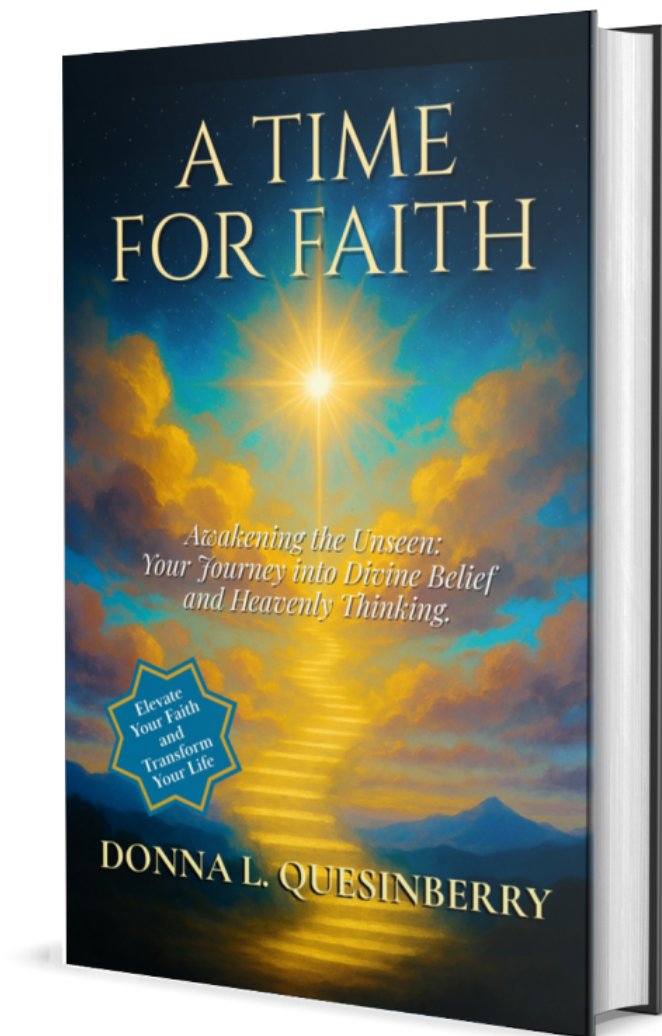


Donna L. Quesinberry Embarks on a Transformative Literary Chapter While Championing Diverse Voices

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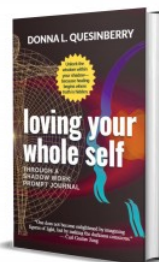
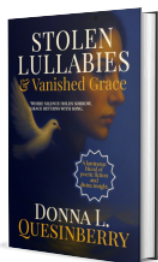
