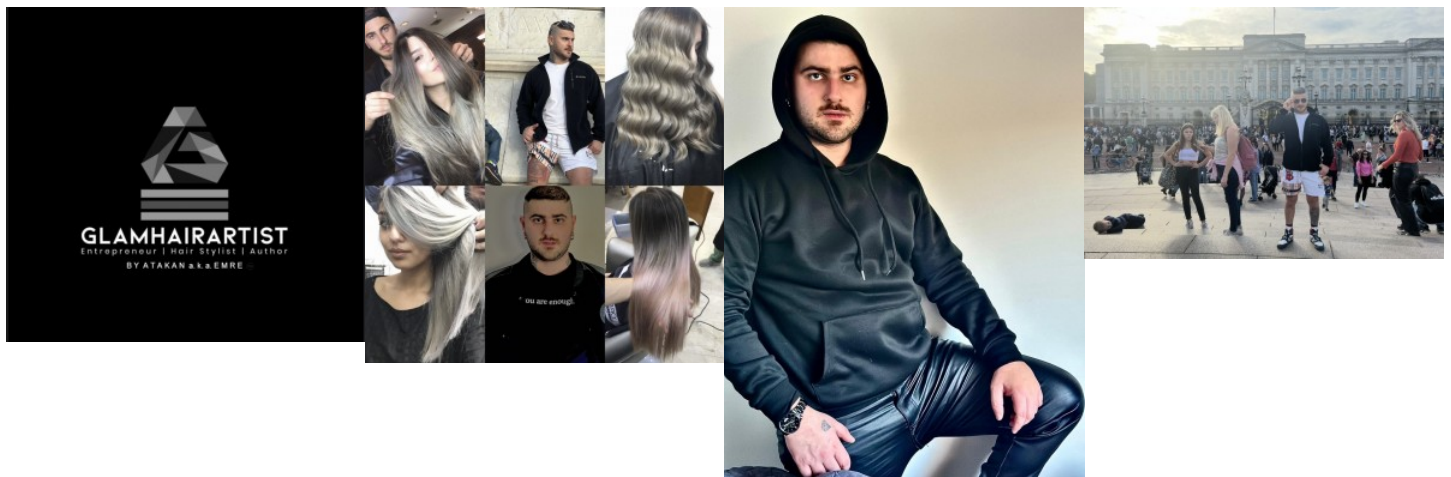
What is the one piece of advice you would give to your younger self, knowing what you know now about the industry and your career? Stay motivated no matter what happens at all times as it's a growing industry.
