
Introducing Sahara CyberStars latest release 'I Wanna Go Home'

Dave Long and Trish Long have remastered this original full band soul rock track that features passionate vocals, rhythmic electric guitar, brass section and nostalgic alto sax solo. This track is described as a 'song with meaning'



Stawell, Victoria Jul 11, 2025 (<u>Issuewire.com</u>) - A quick introduction to the band <u>'Sahara</u> <u>CyberStars'</u> that is made up of the award winning singer/songwriters Dave Long and Trish Long who met on the vibrant Dublin music scene in their homeland Ireland in the mid eighties. They performed in

many of the renowned music venues there until the economic downturn saw them migrating to Australia. There they continued their songwriting and performing successfully appearing on all the major TV networks, live to air on radio as well as festival appearances and several concert tours.

Trish Long and Dave Long's music is all original and has been described as 'eclectic' weaving between rock, soul, jazz, R&B and Celtic. But don't be fooled by this duo - they embraced the power of the synth early in the piece and they pride themselves on the full band sound they have created which has received many compliments. They were also music pioneers in the nineties becoming the first Australian act to go to No.1 on the First Internet Music charts based in New York which led to an interview on the ABC evening news Australia. They followed this with another one of their songs going to No. 1 and from there they started to take their concert on the road around eastern and southern Australia from cities to the outback.

Sahara CyberStars have released six albums and eight singles to date. Currently they are in their studio and between releasing new songs they have found time to re-master a title called 'I Wanna Go Home' which they released on July 10th, 2025. Looking at the state of the world they felt this was the time for this song. 'I Wanna Go Home' is a soul rock ballad that is a plea to people who haven't had to leave their homeland through circumstances beyond their control, to understand that the names 'refugees' and 'migrants' refer to real people who are struggling to find a 'home' in a hostile world. This track features Dave Long on lead vocals and electric guitar and Trish Long on vocals and alto sax.
