Its voice identifies — thoughts of a poet, hunger cries, voice of a mother, struggle of an orphan child, father's love, a great hindustan, anklets, bangles, life of a girl child, various festivities, the feel of a soulmate, the inner space, nostalgia, romance and more. Soneto Universal, a collection of Sonnets by an Indian author **Philip Isukapati**, enshrines pristine literature which embodies a rich artistry of traditional, poetic and profound literary where the very deeper verses are coherently coordinated and intertwined to simmer a passion to create the finest collection of the most stylistic and passionate words into verses — sonnets.

The title refers to “deeper offerings of a universal soul,” and these sonnets are based on **16th century English literature**, recalling those wonderful and mellifluous little songs. Philip Isukapati wrote this entire collection of one hundred sonnets between **Jan 2023 – May 2024**.

Distinct Imagery:

Philip Isukapati's poetry/fiction is rich in figurative illustration, delineating thematic poems for the reader's lucid sight, feel, and imagination.

Exploration of beauty, love, loss and gain:

Philip Isukapati grips with the subjects of love and its illusive nature and the joy or grief of life in its various moods, often expressing these elements through his use of strong and emotive feelings and nature imagery.

Metric Style:

Philip Isukapati's eye for metric poetry, using figurative language and poetic elements like scale, rhythm, and meter to create subtle and emotionally meaningful resonant verses — exploring nature, beauty, philosophy and imagery.

Use of nature, beauty and protectionism:

Philip Isukapati quite often draws upon nature, beauty and wonders if it could be lost, imbibing his poems with a sense of imagery with subtle exigency for protectionism.

Influence of Romanticism:

Philip Isukapati's emotive work deeply reflects his romantic mind's focus on nature, emotion, and unquantifiable life as an experience.

Special message:

He says, “ he writes to live or live to write and may live or die but now he writes to leave his imprints to the world — is the real cause of his poetic mind.”

And he believes —

Words are wonderful, they define everything and the world. This creation or this universe or God in its entirety exists through these wonderful words. If words aren't magical or no life, then prayers are null and even God isn't existent. More importantly, the words of the poetic mind travel by oceans and even by clouds, the words of the poetic mind feel the moon or the stars close by, and the words of the poetic mind even feel her illusive love in the skies. A poetic mind is a cosmic prowess which can hold the entire universe at its will. Blessed are the poets who have those magical words which certainly define you and me, and the entire nature or the universe: the sun, the moon, and the stars as many a time beyond their existence. Poets can think more deeply than what they can as they think to yield very beautiful words the world needs in. Ah! A poetic mind savours thoughts and nothing much pleases it all.
