Owino's latest book is also in development, weaving autobiographical threads with sharp social

With a background in music, literature, and visual art, Owino blends past and present into a powerful statement: that the Rainbow Child is not a victim, but a visionary.

"Rainbow was once a label whispered in shame," Owino reflects. "Now, it's a badge of beauty and resistance."
