Since 2006, he has written fiction and non-fiction works spanning memoir, management, and political commentary. His previous titles include *Corruption*, *Human Resource Management Made Easy*, *Handling Discipline and Grievance in the Workplace*, and *Touch and Go*—a deeply personal account of his battle with COVID-19 after spending nearly a month in an induced coma. "An Act of Sedition" marks his return to fiction and delivers a powerful warning and an enduring message of hope.

Mike is currently working on a historical novel about Britain's early democracy movements—continuing his commitment to stories that illuminate social justice and resilience.

"I was inspired by the way authoritarian and populist political figures and parties have increasingly inserted themselves into mainstream politics in Europe, the UK, and the US," says Mike. I wanted to write a story that reminds us how democracy, once lost, can be almost impossible to regain—and how important it is to fight to protect it."

Blending current political anxieties with echoes of history—such as the fall of the Weimar Republic and the Nazi takeover of Germany in 1933— "An Act of Sedition" serves as a sobering reflection on modern society and its democratic institutions. The novel also celebrates the power of cultural resistance—through writing, music, and community—as a counterforce to state propaganda and control.


Message from the Author
