What followed was two years of repeated hospitalizations, seventeen near-death experiences, and the fight to qualify for a transplant. In December 2024, against the odds, he received a donor liver.

Lessons in Resilience

Reynard does not shy away from the darkest moments — nights spent in unbearable pain, the isolation of medical waiting rooms, or the despair of feeling abandoned by those closest to him. But *Stronger than Before* is ultimately a book about resilience. Through therapy, sobriety, faith, and the support of friends, coworkers, and family, Reynard discovered a determination that carried him through.

The memoir is also a tribute to the power of community. Reynard writes candidly about the people who showed up when he needed them most, whether by sitting at his hospital bedside, adding his name to prayer lists, or simply offering a kind word when he had none left for himself.

Beyond the Page: Advocacy and Purpose

Today, Reynard is an outspoken advocate for organ donation, LGBTQ rights, and self-acceptance. His motto — "Always Forward, Never Backward!" — reflects the philosophy that emerged from his ordeal. Through speaking engagements and personal storytelling, he now works to inspire others to face their own challenges with courage.

After decades of personal struggle, his world shifted again with the onset of stage 4 liver cancer and liver failure.
