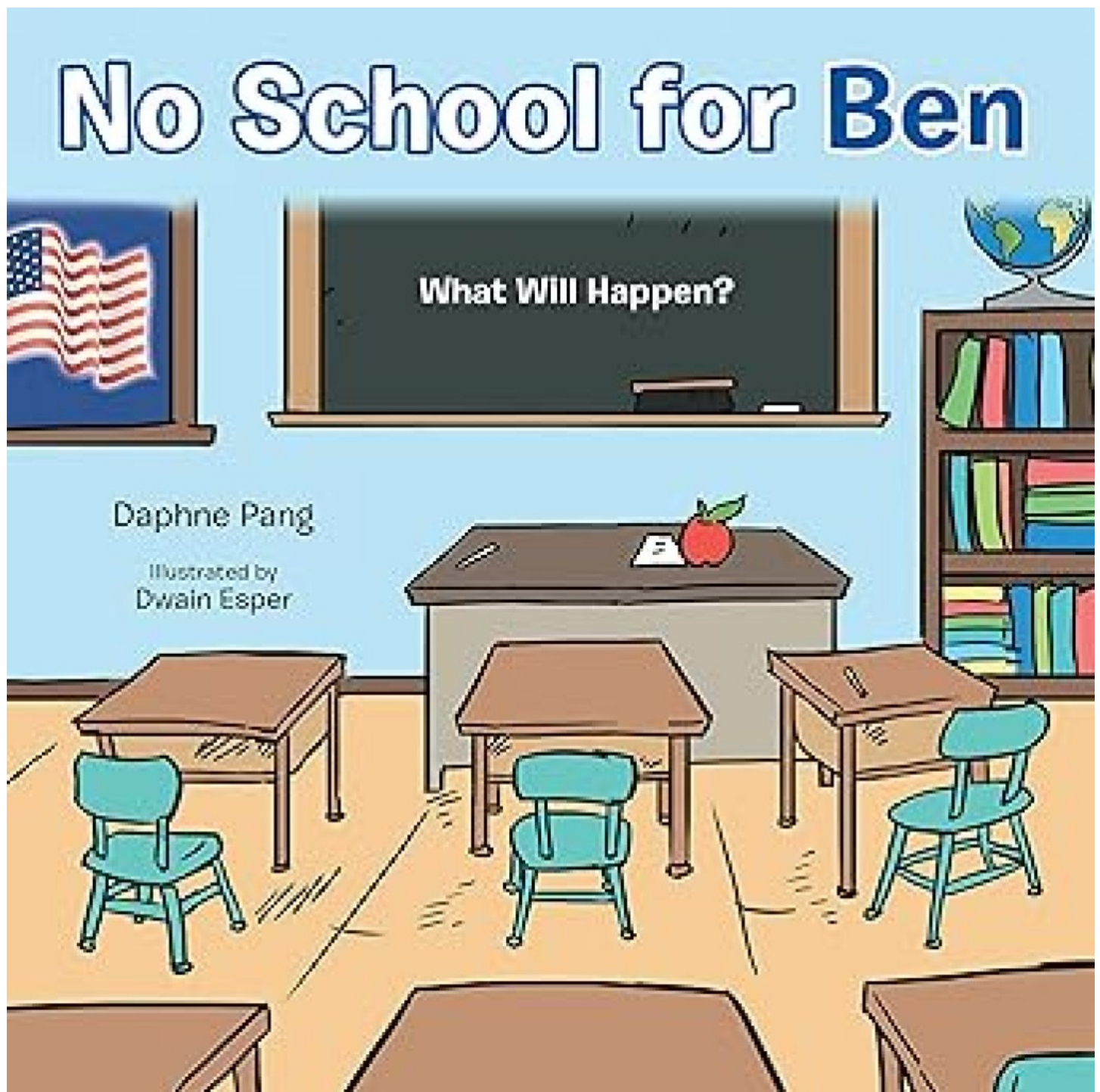


Author Daphne Pang Showcases *No School for Ben* at Frankfurt and Guadalajara International Book Fairs 2025
