
David Cole's The Lion of God Introduces a Cosmic Saga of Identity and Transformation

Beyond his technical accomplishments, Cole is an artist at heart. He created the video game *Hunt The Muglump*, available on Steam and iOS, and developed the iOS app *Gematria Wizard*. In recent years, he has turned to filmmaking and live-streaming, producing projects such as *No One is Your Enemy* and *Dear Lilith, I Love You (Sweet Dreams)*, which has been submitted to multiple international film festivals and has already won the best director award from New York Tri-State International Film Festival. He also runs Venomous Press and Old Skool Games and Software, offering software development and creative projects alike.

Cole's personal tastes lean toward the overlooked and the unconventional. A lifelong fan of classic horror and science fiction films of the 70s through the 90s, he finds inspiration in the cultural artifacts most people have forgotten. He lives on Florida's Gulf Coast with his wife Sarah and their son Elijah,

where he continues to merge technology, art, and storytelling into original works.
