This cross-cultural perspective gives his music a distinctive voice that resonates with listeners searching for connection and understanding.

"I want the music to be the centerpiece," Kahnin explains. "Listeners should interpret it in their own way—that's the real connection."

His previous work includes emotionally charged tracks like "Spider," which deals with personal battles and inner demons, and "Stardust," which explores themes of imagination and identity. Kahnin's approach to music centers on honesty and authenticity, creating songs that help listeners feel less alone in their life journey.

Kahnin describes his music as "putting words and melodies to feelings that are often hard to express and creating something that listeners can see themselves in." Whether addressing moments of joy, struggle, or quiet reflection, his goal remains consistent: reminding people they're not alone in their experiences. This philosophy has guided his artistic development since transitioning from a lifelong music companion to a dedicated recording artist.

Looking ahead, Kahnin plans to release a trio of upcoming singles: "Ketamine Dream," "WIMPI Part 1," and "WIMPI Part 2." He's also planning a small tour for 2026, focusing on intimate live shows that prioritize authentic audience connection over large-scale spectacle. These performances will emphasize the storytelling aspect of his music and create meaningful moments between artist and audience.

The release of "Big Boy" continues Kahnin's exploration of familiar themes with fresh sonic directions. Working with respected artists like Emilia Húgrún represents his ongoing commitment to collaboration while maintaining focus on the music rather than seeking the spotlight. His dedication to craft over celebrity reflects the artistic integrity that has defined his musical approach.
