Her expertise and leadership were recognized in late 2019 with a promotion to ICU Clinical Supervisor, where she mentored fellow nurses, coordinated multidisciplinary care, and ensured operational excellence in high-pressure environments. Seeking to expand her impact, Marphyrose pursued a Master of Science in Nursing – Family Nurse Practitioner (MSN-FNP) at Chamberlain University, achieving board certification in April 2021 and graduating in May 2021.

Since December 2021, Marphyrose has served as a Nephrology Nurse Practitioner, specializing in chronic kidney disease (CKD), acute kidney injury (AKI), and end-stage renal disease (ESRD). Her role is multifaceted, encompassing patient assessment, diagnosis, and comprehensive care. She conducts thorough history-taking and physical exams, interprets lab results and imaging, and diagnoses renal conditions such as CKD, acute kidney injury, electrolyte imbalances, uncontrolled hypertension, fluid management, and more. She monitors disease progression, manages comorbidities like hypertension and diabetes, and educates patients on lifestyle, diet, and medication management to optimize long-term kidney health.

Marphyrose also oversees dialysis care, coordinating initiation, monitoring treatments, managing complications, and ensuring proper access for hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis. She manages medication regimens, adjusting prescriptions based on renal function and lab results.
