Between May 1 and May 5, 2025, an unauthorized actor accessed certain email accounts at Print Media Association. The breach was discovered on May 5, 2025, and notice was provided to potentially impacted individuals on September 10, 2025.

Information Potentially Exposed

Impacted data may include:

- Names
- Social Security Numbers
- Driver's License and other government-issued ID numbers
- Financial account information

Why This Matters

A breach of this scale places those affected at heightened risk of identity theft, fraud, and scamming. Consequences may include fraudulent charges or the posting of private information on the dark web. Many individuals also experience increased phishing attempts or spam after such incidents.

Steps for Protection

Experts recommend placing a fraud alert with the credit bureaus and monitoring financial and medical accounts for unusual activity. **Tip:** Call Experian at 888-397-3742 to place a free fraud alert.
