
Retina Group of Florida Data Breach Possibly Exposed Info for 153,429 Individuals



Washington, D.C, District of Columbia Sep 24, 2025 (<u>Issuewire.com</u>) - Retina Group of Florida recently disclosed a data breach that may have compromised personal data for 153,429 individuals. Migliaccio & Rathod LLP is monitoring developments as the organization investigates the incident.

What Happened

- Between **November 6 and November 9, 2024**, Retina Group of Florida experienced unauthorized access to part of its network.
- The breach was discovered on **November 9, 2024**, and the company issued notice to potentially affected individuals on **September 16, 2025**.

The exact types of information accessed are not yet fully identified.

Possible Risks

- Victims of data breaches often face identity theft resulting in fraudulent charges to financial or medical accounts.
- Personal information may be used in unauthorized applications for credit or medical services.
- There is a risk of personal data being shared online or sold, and an increase in spam, phishing, or suspicious calls/texts.

Steps You Can Take

- Monitor financial statements, medical bills, and insurance statements for unexpected charges or activity.
- Change passwords especially if the same one is used in multiple places; consider using a password manager.
- Enable two-factor authentication (2FA) on your important accounts.
- Place a fraud alert or credit freeze through one of the major credit bureaus (Equifax, Experian, TransUnion).
