"I was born in Peru, and this project is personal," said Michel Martín Rohner Molina, co-founder of Cusco Canine Rescue and the photographer behind the book. "Every trip back, we saw dogs starving, beaten, or poisoned. No creature deserves that violence. This book is our way to turn witness into action—from pages to a place of safety."

What's in the campaign

• **The Book:** Street Dogs of Cusco — a museum-grade, finely printed hardcover featuring portraits, street scenes, and stories that humanize the crisis and honor the bond between people and dogs in the Andes.

- **Rewards & Add-ons:** collector postcards, a 2026 wall calendar, handmade Peruvian bracelets, a second-copy add-on, and special supporter tiers (feature your dog in the Supporters section of the book or be named on the donor wall at the sanctuary).

"This isn't just a book—it's a catalyst," added co-founder Dillon Charles Beckmann. "Proceeds help launch veterinary care, land acquisition, and community education tied to the sanctuary—a permanent, open-air refuge with dignity built in."

Kickstarter allows the team to connect directly with a global community that values meaningful photography and animal welfare. By pledging for the book, backers **both** receive a beautiful first edition **and** help jump-start sanctuary construction and outreach in Cusco.
