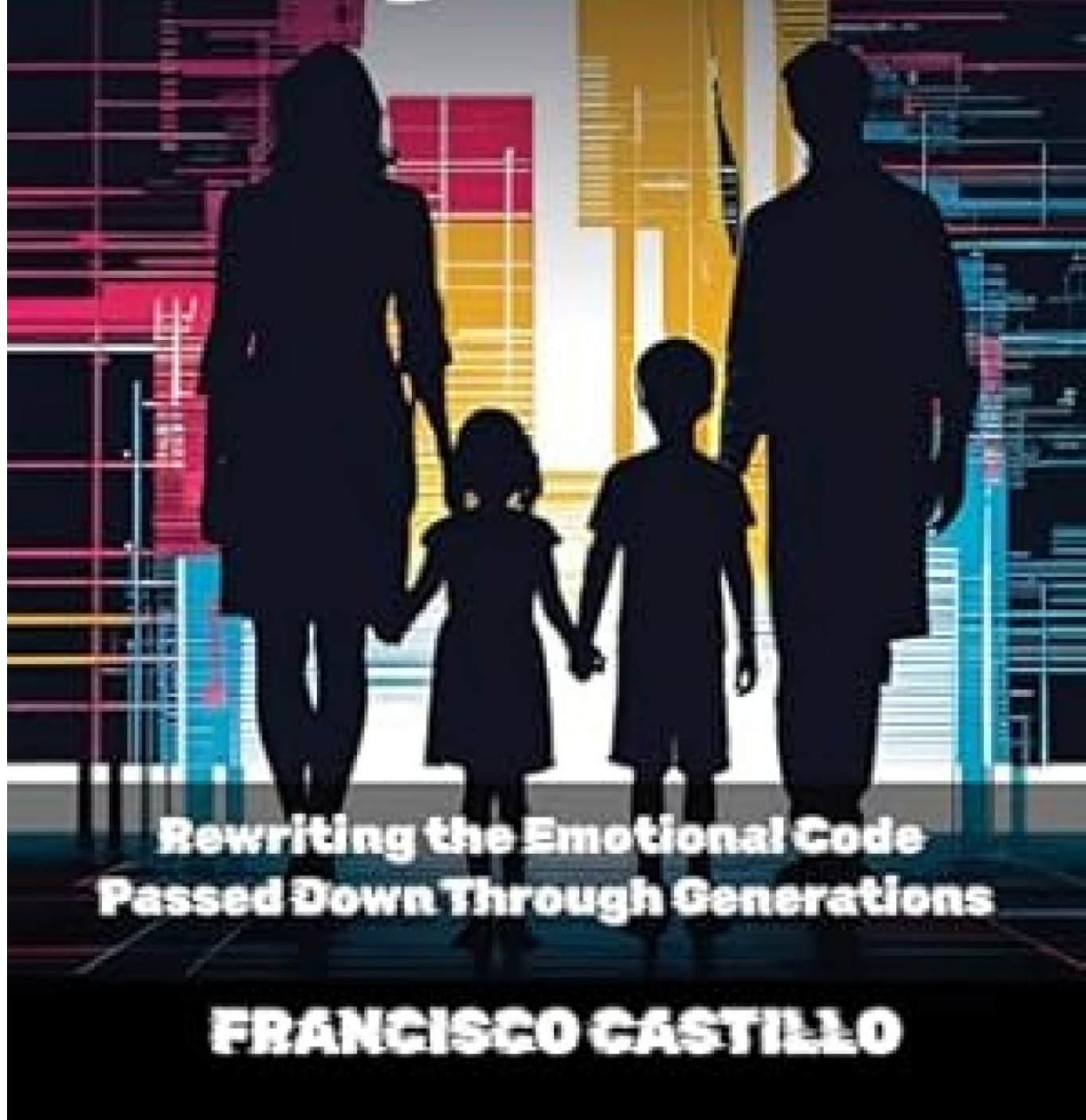


The Generational Algorithm by Francisco Castillo — Breaking the Cycle of Inherited Family Trauma

Castillo's goal is not to overwhelm readers with clinical terminology but to speak plainly about how change really happens. By weaving research with relatable examples, he provides both clarity and hope: people are not broken, they are simply running outdated emotional software that can, with effort and support, be rewritten.

At a time when mental health conversations are becoming more open yet many still struggle to connect with traditional therapeutic language, *The Generational Algorithm* arrives as both timely and necessary.
